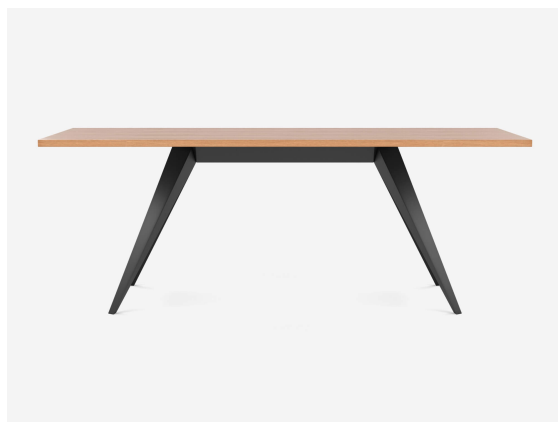

MIXING TOGETHER SCULPTURAL LINES AND VISUAL SIMPLICITY THE MESA DINETTE AND RECTANGULAR DINING TABLES MAKE AN IMPACTFUL STATEMENT IN DINING OR KITCHEN APPLICATIONS. BOTH TABLES CAN BE USED FOR COMMERCIAL APPLICATIONS MAKING FOR GREAT WORK SURFACES OR MEETING TABLES..

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Marble is a fragile, natural material to which extra care should be exercised. Consider using trivets, coasters, placements and adhesive felt pads to prevent scratches and damage to the surface.

Marble is a porous material that absorbs liquid quickly and stains easily. Liquid spillage should be quickly addressed by using slightly damp cloth to blot spillage. Avoid wiping action that could spread liquid across surface.

Avoid citrus based solutions, abrasive cleaners, chemical solvents, bleach, and furniture polish when cleaning marble. Rather, use mild non acidic ones such as hydrogen peroxide.

Changes in temperature and humidity may cause cracking in the oak and walnut - but will not compromise the structural integrity of the product.

How to care for your solid wood top.

Oak, Black Oak and Walnut tops are made of solid wood with an oiled finish. This allows the transparency of the solid wood to come through and gives a natural feel to the surface. Edges are squared with a 2mm radius.

Mesa Marble Top 54" is 1" thick and composed entirely of Chinese white marble.

Mesa rectangular dining top is a 1.5" thick Italian Carrara marble constructed with an internal honeycomb core. Top and edges are 6mm solid marble with the honeycomb core embedded within. Matte finish.

Base and legs are made of powder-coated sheet metal.

Assembly required.

Weight capacity is 268lbs.

Marble tops - made in China.
Oak and Walnut tops - made in Canada.
All bases - made in China

How to care for your solid wood table

Solid wood remains a live medium and will dry out over time. Re-oiling the products is required to maintain the resilience and the beauty of the wood. We recommend that the table be re-oiled every 1-2 years depending on the relative humidity of the environment it is in (35% Relative Humidity or higher is optimal). The tops are currently treated with Rubio Monocoat Pure 2C Oil, which is a plant-based hard wax oil wood finish that is 0% VOC. Its unique technology forms a molecular bond with the topmost fibers of the wood. Once the fibers have bonded with the oil, the wood doesn't absorb any surplus liquids making it an excellent option for protecting the wood from spills and water rings.

Surfaces treated with Rubio Monocoat oil are easy to maintain, and isolated scratches or damaged areas are very easy to repair. To further protect the surface of your table use placemats and coasters at all times.

Steps for re-oiling with Rubio Monocoat Pure 2C Oil:

- 1.) Sand to 120 and then to 150 grit. For best results, be cautious not to over sand.
- 2.) Remove all dust from the tabletop's surface*
- 3.) Apply oil to the bottom side of the tabletop first**
- 4.) Flip the table and apply oil to the top and sides to evenly cover as much of the surface as possible**
- 5.) Wipe up excess oil using newsprint, terry cloths or blue shop towels
- 6.) Allow tabletop to sit undisturbed in a well-ventilated area for at least 24 hours before using again

*Note: After sanding, clean the area well preferably using a raw wood cleaner. Alternatively, you may use a soft bristled brush and a vacuum to remove the dust.

**Pro Tip: Use a clean squeegee to spread the oil evenly over the surface and use newsprint, terry cloths or blue shop towels to wipe up excess oil. Keep wiping the table down until the cloths aren't absorbing any more oil."
